## RAFAEL CRUZ, Las rebeliones militares en la España de entreguerras

In this text the main characteristics of two Spanish military rebellions particularly important are analyzed: the 1923, which ended the regime of the *Restauración*, and 1936, which did the same with that of the Second Republic. It points out the conflict between the military and governments, shared definitions of the situations, the capacity to rebel and staging of the rebellions that materialize the final showdown with the governments to which the military attempted to move.
