LUCA MENCONI, Un diario inedito della Repubblica Sociale Italiana. Bruno Spampanato nell'ultima fase del governo di Mussolini

In the context of the rich memorial existing on the Italian Social Republic season, this contribution intends to investigate an unpublished diary, written by the fascist journalist Bruno Spampanato and his wife, Giuseppa Maiolo. Traced in two distinct versions, with few variants, it describes the political and human vicissitudes of the two spouses from October 1943 to March 2, 1945, marked by meetings and important roles, such as the direction of the newspaper «Il Messaggero» of Rome. Through contrasts, gossip and insinuations, the diary records the attempts of the internal left of fascism to make space in the meshes of the Italian Social Republic, efforts being only partially crowned with success.
