GIOVANNI SEDITA, La spia degli storici. Aldo Romano e «Nuova Rivista Storica»

In the year 1946, Aldo Romano's name appeared in the list of the Ovra spies published by the Alto Commissario per le sanzioni contro il fascismo. Many antifascists wanted to defend him because he had been socialist, confined and Resistance partisan. Indeed, with the pseudonym *Cesare* and the number 543, in the year 1934 Romano wrote many informative reports for the fascist Politic Police. In these reports he denounced Benedetto Croce, Nello Rosselli, Leone Ginzburg, Ferdinando Amendola. In particular, his actions hit the journal «Nuova Rivista Storica». The Aldo Romano's path from antifascism to fascism seems exemplary: Mussolini's regime, with his repressive machine, was able to build with the intellectual a relationship based on communication through coercions and concessions.
