FRANCO CARDINI, Ugo Tucci tra Parigi, Venezia e il Mediterraneo (a un anno dalla scomparsa)

Ugo Tucci, eminent economic historian and expert in the history of Venice, developed his research activities in ongoing dialogue with the outcomes of the historiography of the “Annales” from Lucien Febvre to Fernand Braudel. His most important studies concern the history of the Mediterranean Sea, navigation and Venice between XIII and XVII centuries. He died in Perugia one year ago, on March 13th, 2013. He often worked in important standard works with historians such Ruggiero Romano and Alberto Tenenti. Until his last moments he attended his studies with serenity and perspicuity.
