LÁSZLÓ CSORBA, Agenti segreti ungheresi a Roma nella prima metà degli anni Cinquanta

The author presents a previously unknown chapter of the Italian-Hungarian relations: how had been working the Hungarian Communist Party-State's intelligence officers – in the classical sense of the word: the spies – in Italy during the first half of the 1950s. Elaborating the source materials, that become available only nowadays, he explains the structure and the activity of the secret part of the Hungarian Embassy, namely its intelligence residence, and the details of the practical realization of the purposes of the central intelligence office of Budapest. The author introduces how could the Hungarian spies incorporate into various institutions of the Italian state apparatus.
