ENRICO GORI, Czechoslovakian Challenges. The Sudeten Germans, Upper Silesia and Transcarpathia from the collapse of Austria-Hungary to the end of interwar Czechoslovakia, 1918-1939

This paper analyzes the development of the national questions arising in the Czechoslovakian state since its formation in November 1918: the Germans residing in the Sudeten region of Western Bohemia, the industrial region of Těšín/Zaolzie in Upper Silesia, claimed by Poland, and Subcarpathian Ruthenia/Transcarpathia, claimed by Hungary, and how they ultimately led to the First Czechoslovakian Republic's isolation, partition and destruction.
